

2023 Jamíson Cup Fort Mill Golf Course

TEES TO PLAY

Everyone will play WHITE tee markers. Seniors 65 and older play GOLD tee markers. Super Seniors 75 and older will play RED tee markers (These are the default tees. If all 4 members of your group agree to change tees, this is permissible)

FORMAT

Saturdays format is Modified Alternate Shot (All 18 holes). You and your partner will both tee off on every hole and then select which one you want to play. The person whose tee shot was not selected hits the next shot and from there you will alternate every shot until the ball is either holed or the putt is conceded. Lift, clean, and place within a scorecard length through the green, excluding penalty areas and bunkers for this format

Sundays format will have 3 different matches within each group. There is a best ball match with you and your partner against the two guys from the other team. There is also a singles match between you and a player on the other team (on the Sunday pairings sheet, your opponent for singles is the name across from yours). We will play lift, clean, and place within a clublength in YOUR OWN FAIRWAY on Sunday

SCORING

1 point will be awarded for the front 1 for the back, and 2 for the overall in each match on Saturday

1 point will be awarded for the front, 1 for the back, and 1 for the overall in each match on Sunday

OUT OF BOUNDS

Out of bounds is defined by white stakes. Paved roadways on #6, #12, #13, #15 are Out of Bounds. On #18, any ball that comes to rest left of the cart path on #10 tee box is Out of Bounds (This area has been marked with white paint)

ROOT/ROCK RULE

If your swing path is interfered by a root or rock, you are entitled to a free drop nearest point of relief within one club length. This does not include if your ball comes to rest at the trunk of the tree (it must be played as it lies).

RULINGS

PACE OF PLAY

Keep up with the group in front of you. If you do not keep pace you may be subjected to a loss of hole if you are deemed to have taken more than the allotted time it takes to play. We will have clocks and rangers monitoring you if you fall behind and will be subjected to a penalty
